### COMPUTERIZED ENTRY SYSTEM WILL SIMPLIFY YOUR LIFE

#### IT'S SIMPLE. GO TO THE WEBSITE, FIND THE ENTRY FORM, FILL IT OUT, AND PRINT IT

For the first couple shows you'll need to print out the completed form and bring it to the entry booth with your payment. If all goes smoothly, eventually we'll do everything except payment online, so all you'll need to do the morning of the show is come to the booth and pay your fees.

#### MORE ENGLISH CLASSES

English walk-trot is now offered as three age-specific classes, and will count for year-end points. There will also be an English walk-trot jackpot class.

#### SEPARATE TRAIL CLASSES

Last year's experiment with running trail classes concurrent with other classes had some bumps, but overall it was an improvement-- the shows were shorter. This year we'll have a separate trail judge, and trail class will be from 2-4 p.m. at every show.

#### SHOW DATES

As always, the first Saturday of May, June, July, August, and September. July and September are double-judged. October will be a fun show, unless we need it for a rain date. Judges are listed on the website.
