ENTRY CARDS

Please remember to fill out the entry form and each class yellow card in full detail i.e. exhibitor number, name, horse's name, and whether you are a club member. Also, remember each entry form is for each horse/rider combination. Jump out fee is \$1.00 for each horse unloaded on the grounds.

BLANK CHECKS/REFUNDS

Flying Arrow Saddle Club will no longer accept blank checks for the show day. Checks must be completely filled out when entry forms are submitted to the entry booth. Payment is due when entry forms are turned into the booth. FASC has a "no refund" policy.

ADDING & SCRATCHING

If you should want to add a class, just inform the entry booth three classes ahead of the class you want to add. And if you are scratching a class or a horse for the rest of the day, PLEASE inform our entry booth. This helps speed along the show by keeping the ring-steward informed of how many entrants should be in the arena for the judge and when to close the gate and proceed. Thank you!

TRASH – CLEAN UP

Please be sure to clean up after yourself. There was several trash items left out on the ground and by the horse trailers.

VOLUNTEERS

Thanks to all who helped with our first show of the season! All the FASC board and members appreciate it. It keeps the show moving along for everyone participating.
